## HISTORY OF THE DRUMHEAD SERVICE

It is a tradition going back for centuries that soldiers on operations, far away from their own churches or chapels on Sunday, would lay their drums together neatly, consecrate them by laying their Colours of Standards on them to be used as a make-shift altar and central focus for the service. This tradition continues to be honoured in Regiments and Battalions wherever they happen to be stationed in the world.


